Pi Sigma Alpha is the national political science honors society with 621 chapters throughout the country. San Diego State's chapter, Gamma Upsilon, was initially formed in 1959. It is a student-run organization that accepts applications to the honor society and organizes various activities throughout the academic year.

Admissions criteria for membership:

Undergraduates:

- Must have completed at least 60 total units
- Must have completed at least 12 units in political science, at least 6 of which must be upper-division units, with an average GPA of 3.5 or higher in upper-division political science courses
- Must have at least a 3.0 SDSU and 3.0 cumulative GPA
- **Do not** need to be political science majors to qualify for membership

Graduates:

- Must be enrolled in the Political Science M.A. program
- Must have completed at least 9 graduate units in political science, earning at least an A-in all graduate political science courses
- May not use undergraduate coursework toward graduate student eligibility
